Once you start a new application online, you will be directed to create or sign in to your personal *my* Social Security account. You will need a valid email address to create your account. All new *my* Social Security customers will create a credential with one of our two credential partners, Login.gov or ID.me. If you don't have a Login.gov or ID.me account, select the "Create an Account" link to start this one-time registration process. If you create a new Login.gov credential, we will still complete the identity verification part, so you will need to provide some personal information to us.

If you are unable to create a *my* Social Security account, you can continue your application online and we will contact you when we receive and review your application.
